RULES POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The following are guidelines the Everett Public Schools imposes on all groups that use Memorial Stadium: These guidelines, policies and procedures are established to ensure everyone has a successful performance and a wonderful time. Any group choosing to violate or disregard the above can expect penalties and/or band disqualification. Thank you for your cooperation.

Warm-up

Your band will be escorted by a designated band host. Only warm up in your assigned area at the

designated time. This includes Pit as well as Drum Line and Color Guard.

Field Exit

EXIT TO THE SOUTH EAST CORNER AFTER YOUR BANDS PERFORMANCE ONLY!

Pit Vehicle ONLY GOLF CARTS on the track

Use your pit vehicle to the gate.

- If your vehicle is not an electric golf cart, one is available to use while on the track.
- Do not drag items on the field.
- You must have wheels on each vehicle, cart trailer, or other items that are pushed or pulled.
- Vehicles that do not meet the above criteria will not be allowed on the track or field. Determination of vehicle status is left to the Field Coordinator. ATV's are NOT allowed by Everett School District.

Equipment/Vehicles

Buses or equipment vehicles will be assigned parking by a Puget Sound Festival of Bands parking attendants. All other spectator vehicles must park in the South Stadium Parking Lot.

General guidelines

The use of mechanized vehicles, drones, live animals, open flame, incense, or fireworks on the field or warm up areas is not permitted.

Clean up Courtesy

- Plastic bags will be provided and regularly picked up by our Clean up Crew.
- Refrain from using local business dumpsters.
- Remove and take with you all props, pop-up tents and large items.
- Clean up any food waste you have brought in.
- If this is your last Marching Competition for the season, do not leave your props, dispose of at your own school.

Use of Doctor Beat or Gock Block - PLEASE DO NOT USE AT ANY TIME!

Wristbands You will receive 1 Director's name badge, 6 wristbands for instructors, and one additional wristband for each 10 members of your band for chaperones. Additional chaperone wristbands can be purchased for \$15 each at the ticket booth. Circuit Passes of any kind are not accepted at Puget Sound Festival of Bands.

Field

The contest field is a regulation sized high school football field, 160 feet wide and 300 feet long. The boundaries of the field are marked in white, and it is lined every five yards. The hash marks are marked one third of the way off each sideline (52 feet 4 Inches). Numbered yard markers are placed every 10 yards along the front sideline. Each of the four corners are marked with a cone as is the front and back 50-yard line.

Retreat

There will be no playing of any kind once retreat is finished. Both the City and the County have a noise ordinance that starts at 10PM.
